From the Hair and Makeup Departments

HAIR

Men/Boys –

Please come with your hair clean with no product in it.

Hair in 1962 was short and well groomed. Extras need to be prepared that if hair is considered too long for the time period, hair is subject to being cut shorter.

Women/Girls –

If you think you can handle doing a hairstyle on yourself circa 1962, please do. A simple Google search of 1962 Fashion will bring up many reference images of women's hairstyles of the time. Also, if you are a fan of Mad Men, Seasons 1-3 all have appropriate hair for women.

If you are not comfortable with doing it yourself, please come with your hair pre-curved with hot rollers, setting rollers, or a curling iron.

For young girls, parents, please pre-curl their hair. If your child's hair doesn't curl, pigtails and braids. Styles you can also bring them with are half-up/half-down with curls.

MAKEUP

for MEN:

- Please come with face shaved and moisturized (don't forget your neck and ears)
- WEAR SUNSCREEN under your makeup!!
- Bring Powder and Blot Papers to reduce shine throughout your time on set

(recommend RCMA no color powder, found at Makeup Mania in Denver or Theatrical Costumes, etc. in Boulder. Blot papers can be found at most drug stores)

- Bring Powder and Blot Papers to reduce shine throughout your time on set

(I like MAC Studiofix Foundation applied with a fluffy powder brush and ProLongwear Concealer, the makeup artists in the store will help you match your color.)

- **DO NOT USE MINERAL MAKEUP!!**(it turns to paste if you get hot)
- Google 'Mad Men' for inspiration

Things to Remember:

- Men are very clean cut in 1962
- Try not to go overboard!! Less is more!!

MAKEUP
for WOMEN:

- Clean 1950's and EARLY 1960's makeup
- Liquid liner, strong brows and matte red lips (Russian Red from MAC and Valkyrie from NARS are two good colors)
- WEAR SUNSCREEN under your foundation!!!
- Bring Powder and Blot Papers to reduce shine throughout your time on set
- Bring your lip color for your touch ups.
- Google Mad Men or makeup trends for 1962 inspiration
- **NO SHIMMER OR GLITTER**
- **NO FALSE LASHES**
- **DO NOT USE MINERAL MAKEUP!!** (it turns to paste when you get hot)

CHILDREN:

- Please apply and bring sunscreen for your children
- Blot Papers to reduce shine
- Chapstick with sunscreen in it so they don't burn their lips!
